

St Andrew Square Garden wins Civic Trust Award

St Andrew Square Garden in Edinburgh has received a commendation award at the Civic Trust Awards which took place in London on 18th March. Land Engineering received a certificate for their involvement as Main Contractor on the project working for City of Edinburgh Council. Commendations are given to schemes that are of benefit culturally, socially or economically whilst making a valuable contribution to the quality and appearance of the environment.

Launched in 1959, the Civic Trust Awards is one of the oldest built environment award schemes in Europe.
