Developed after intensive consultation with the local ethnic communities within Pollokshields, the Hidden Garden is the first 'peace garden' created to serve the public. This project exhibits many artistic statements including complex timber, metal and masonry features.

Activities

- Complicated hard and soft landscaping forms have been created to reflect the ethnic origin of the design
- Himalayan and Asian cultivars have been planted in contrast to native British species, to express the partnership that exists within the local communities.
